

# The twofold anointing of the Holy Spirit

1. The anointing of the Holy Spirit **in** us      The Spirit in me
2. The anointing of the Holy Spirit **on** us      I in the Spirit

When born-again we have been sealed with the Holy Spirit      The Spirit **in** me  
At Pentecost we received the power from on the Holy Spirit      The Spirit **on** me.

## The Spirit in us

John 4:14      Indeed, the water I give him will become **in** him a spring  
2Cor 1:22      ..and put His Spirit **in** our hearts as a deposit  
John 14:17      The Spirit of Truth...lives with you and will be **in** you  
Rom 8:9      You however...by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives **in** you  
Rom 8:11      ..will give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who lives **in** you  
1John 4:4      Greater is He that is **in** you, than he that is in the world  
1John 2:27      the anointing remains **in** you, and you do not need anyone...

Conclusion: The Spirit in you is:

- The teacher within (John 16:12-15)
- The inner fountain (water only for you)
- The seal of Gods ownership (Eph. 1:14)
- The inner witness, that testifies with your spirit (Rom. 8:16)
- The Spirit of truth (your guide) (1John 2:27)
- The Helper for your personal growth
- The Helper to develop the fruit of the spirit

## The Spirit on/upon is

Luke 4:18      The Spirit of the Lord in **upon** me, because He has anointed Me.  
Luke 24:49      I will let the promise of My Father come **on** you  
Acts 1:8      you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes **on** you  
Acts 10:44      while Peter was still speaking the Holy Spirit came **on** all  
Acts 19:6      When Paul placed his hands on them, the Holy Spirit came **on** them,...

Conclusion: The Spirit on you is an:

- Anointing for others and not for yourself
- Anointing for the revelation of the gifts of the Spirit
- Anointing that can increase/decrease or be renewed
- Anointing that comes through faith, thirsting, waiting
- Anointing for preaching the Gospel
- Anointing that comes on you like a cloak (Elijah & Elisha)
- Anointing that produces strength to resist
- Anointing that is promised to us by the Father
- Anointing, similar as the one Jesus was baptized with (Luke 4:18).

Comments: In the Old Testament, this anointing came only on 3 specially chosen kind of people: priests, prophets and kings, until the prophet Joel prophesied: I will pour out My Spirit **upon** all flesh. This happened on the day of Pentecost (Acts 2:16) and is Gods promise for us today.

**What are the characteristics of the Holy Spirit?**

2 Tim.1:7 For God did not give us a Spirit of timidity, but a spirit of: power love and self discipline.

- 1 Cor. 12 Power the gifts of the Spirit Gods power on you
- 1 Cor. 13 Love the Fruits of the Spirit Gods character in you
- 1 Cor. 14 Discipline the balance of the Spirit Gifts & fruits, on & in you.

John 4:13 Wells have to be digged and they can dry out  
 John 4:14 A fountain only feeds himself, turns back and doesn't dry out  
 John 7:38 Streams of living waters, flow out to others

1Cor. 12:4 There are different kinds of **gifts**, but the same **Spirit**  
 There are different kinds of **ministries**, but the same **Lord**  
 There are different kinds of **works**, but the same **God**

Conclusion: Everyone is called to an office and has received an anointing from God to fulfill his calling. That anointing is being strengthened by:

1. Studying the Word of God
2. Prayer and fasting
3. Waiting upon the Lord
4. Walking with fathers (Like Elisha walked with Elijah)

How? \* **How can you practically work out your calling?**

1. Know Gods calling for your personal life
2. Follow Jesus from as close as you can
3. Walk with the man whom God has joined you to  
 Paul said: Follow me like I follow Christ

End: The more yielding, the more anointing.

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
